24th and 25th March 2018

Affiliated to ASA London Region

1. The competition will be swum under A.S.A. Laws and ASA Technical Rules of Swimming at **Fullwell Cross Leisure Centre, 140 High Street, Barkingside, Essex IG6 2EA.**
2. Program of events: **Age 9** - All 50m, 100m, 200m events and 400m Free. **Ages 10 +** all 50m, 100m, 200m, & 400m events. All events will be run on a heat declared winner HDW basis.
Awards will be given to the top 6 in each group. Age groups (9, 10&11, 12&13, 14&15, 16+). **Age is at midnight on the last day of the competition 25th March 2018.**
3. The pool is 25m long, 6 lanes, anti wave lane ropes and electronic timing, with ample spectator seating. Car parking is available close by at a charge for the Saturday.
4. **The entry fees are £6.00 per event.** Entry fees will be forfeited for withdrawals after confirmation lists have been sent/e-mailed. Refunds will be given to the Head Coach/Team Manager on the weekend of the gala. **25m entry times should be submitted.**
5. Travel expenses will be refunded for Officials and given out on the day by the Meet Secretary and should not be deducted from your Club's entry fees.
6. The official **closing date is midnight 23rd February 2018.** All entries must not be faster than the stated Upper Limit Times. Entries may be restricted in order to keep the session times within appropriate time scales – slowest times per individual age within each age group will be rejected but clubs will be refunded for entries rejected in this way. Club entries containing more than 6 swimmers will be requested to provide a licensed official for each session attended. Please advise officials' names, qualification and sessions attending when submitting electronic entries.
7. Swimmers must sign themselves in/register themselves within registration period. Signing in and warm up times will be sent to each club with club entries. Swimmers who register late may be accepted but at the promoter's discretion.
8. **All entries MUST be submitted electronically and emailed to lbrscmeetadm@googlemail.com** (IF YOU ENCOUNTER PROBLEMS WITH ELECTRONIC ENTRIES, PLEASE CONTACT Stephen Richards at the above email address).
9. **BACS payments are preferred, details are LBRSC Sort Code 20-44-22 Account number 20578207 or one single club cheque; payable to LBRSC which should be accompanied by the Financial Summary Sheet and sent to; Stephen Richards, 22 Inverness Drive, Hainault, Ilford, Essex IG6 3BN,** by the official closing date.
10. Coaches, helpers must wear the wristband provided. Only competing swimmers, coaches, officials and helpers are allowed on poolside
11. Admission will be £5 for a whole day (£3 for children & Concessions) A refund of £2.50 will be given if single session only-payable on departure. Full day programs will be sold at a cost of £2.
12. Time Trials **may** be available, on the day of the competition depending on time and availability, and will be charged at £7 per trial. Those submitted for a time trial will not be eligible for an award, though their times will be submitted to ASA rankings.
13. Coaches must monitor the swim down pool. Failure to do this could result in the facility being withdrawn.
14. All meet participants and spectators must observe all safety precautions in operation at Fullwell Cross Leisure Centre and follow the instructions of the pool staff.
15. Swimmers must not go up to the balcony without first drying off and putting on footwear and clothing before leaving the poolside. No outdoor shoes to be worn on the poolside.
16. Competitors are advised not to leave their belongings unattended. Neither LBRSC nor Fullwell Cross Leisure Centre can accept responsibility for any property that is lost or stolen.
17. In accordance with the requirements of the Pool Operator, any person wishing to use video, zoom or close range photography, including mobile phones that have photographic capabilities should first register their details at the spectator entrance; if there is any reason as to why a Parent/Guardian may wish their child not to have any photographic imagery or video recording taken they should inform LBRSC, where they will take the appropriate action. It is requested that all mobile phones are switched off or turned to silent during the competition and that there is no flash photography at the start of each event.

18. Consent is deemed to have been given as required of the data protection act, to the holding and distribution as necessary, of personal information on computer, to run the meet.
